Professor Amy Huey-Ling SHEE obtained her LLM at LSE and PhD in law from Warwick University in 1995, since when she has been affiliated to National Chung Cheng University (CCU) in Taiwan. Apart from being a full-time Professor at the College of Law, Professor Shee also serves for the CCU as the Director of the Taiwan Legal Information Institute (TaiwanLII, <http://www.taiwanlii.ccu.edu.tw/>), the Chairperson of the Human Research Committee, the Coordinator of the Aging Society Legal Studies, and the Director of the Fundamental Law Research Centre. Her research interests are mainly on Family Law, Children Rights, Sociology of Law, Legal Education, and Law & Literature. Upon the governmental appointment since 2012, Prof. Shee has led a research team to work drafts of the Enforcement Law of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) and the CRC National Report. She is now appointed as advisors to child right committees of governmental and non-governmental organs. She received the honour of the “Child Protection Angel National Award 2010” from the hands of the National President.
